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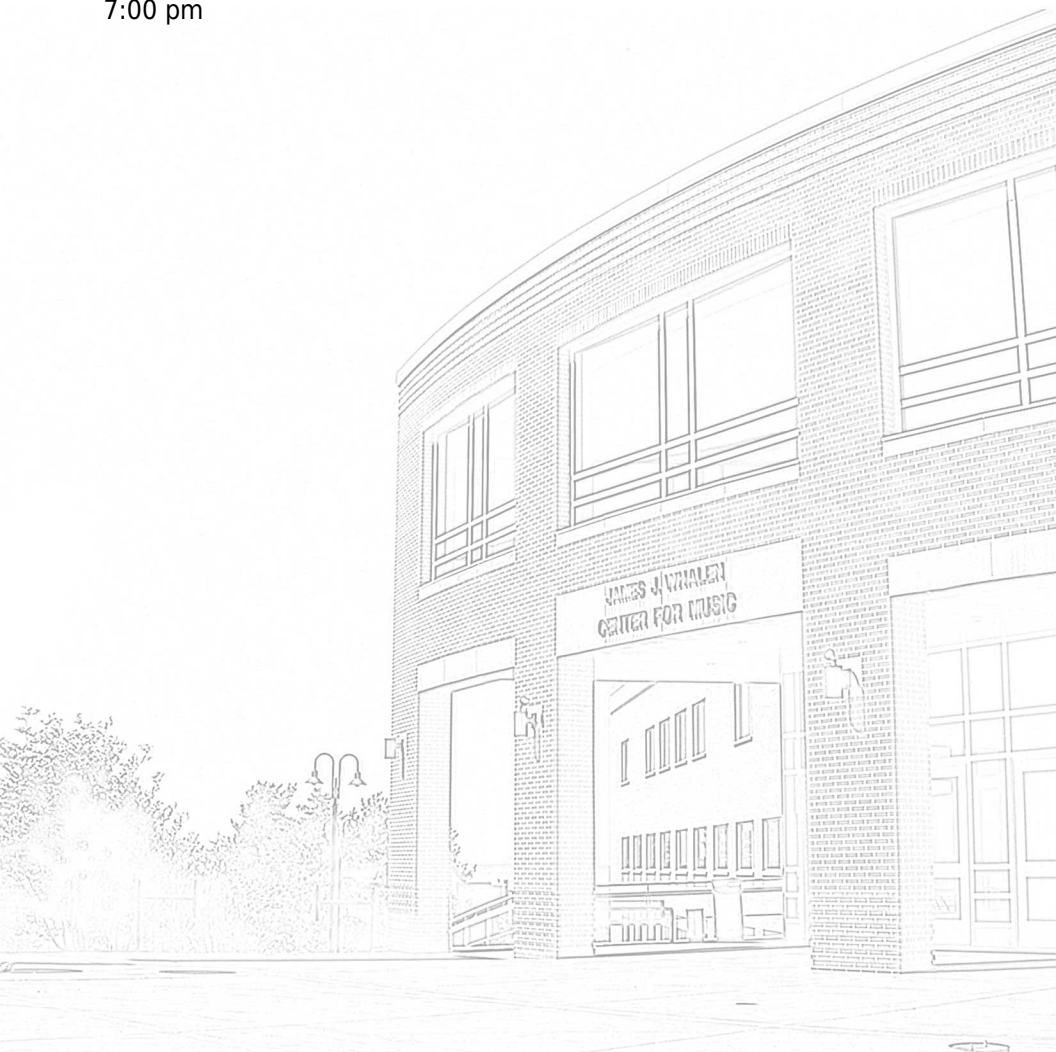

**Kevin Schempf** is Associate Professor of Clarinet at Bowling Green State University, solo clarinetist with the Pittsburgh New Music Ensemble, and he regularly plays Bass Clarinetist with the Toledo Symphony appearing in Carnegie Hall with the Symphony in 2011. A graduate of the Interlochen Arts Academy and the Eastman School of Music, he performed with the United States Coast Guard Band and toured with them throughout the United States and to St. Petersburg, Russia. A frequent soloist with the Band, he was featured on NPR broadcasts and on their 75th Anniversary CD Recording. He was on the faculty at Connecticut College and performed with the New London Contemporary Ensemble. He has also taught at Wesleyan University where he played with the New World Consort, which gave regular concerts throughout Connecticut and in New York City and the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Schempf played Second and Eb clarinet with the Syracuse Symphony Orchestra for nine years, appearing as a concerto soloist on several occasions. He has also performed with the Detroit Symphony, Hong Kong Philharmonic, Boston Symphony Orchestra, the Fort Wayne Philharmonic, the Lima Symphony, Lakeside Symphony and the Chautauqua Orchestra. Chamber music engagements include performing with Brave New Works, the Ying Quartet, concerts and a CD recording with the Society for New Music in Syracuse, NY, appearances at the Skaneateles Festival, the Harkness Festival, the Wall Street Chamber Players, at Lakeside.
