The Conductors

Lori-Anne Dolloff is Coordinator of Music Education at the Faculty of Music, University of Toronto, where she specializes in choral music and elementary music education. Dr. Dolloff received a Ph.D from the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education, where her doctoral work focused on paradigms for teacher education in choral music. She has taught music at pre-school, elementary and middle-school levels, and is the music director of the Mississauga Festival Choir, a community choir dedicated to promoting a quality choral performance experience for singers for all ages and musical background. Dr. Dolloff is also a free-lance organist.

A frequent clinician and adjudicator, Lori Dolloff was awarded the Artist-Teacher Diploma from the Institute for Choral Teacher Education, and has joined the teaching faculty of the choral Music Experience Association, which provides certification courses in choral music education at centers in Great Britain, Europe, the United States and Canada. She is an assisting author, of *We Will Sing!*, a music text designed as a choral curriculum for classroom choirs.

Lawrence Doebler is a professor of music at Ithaca College where he serves as director of choral activities. Currently in his twenty-seventh year at the college, his duties include conducting the Choir, Madrigal Singers, and Choral Union and teaching conducting (both undergraduate courses and graduate majors), choral techniques, and choral literature. The Choir tours annually, most recently to Ireland, and has performed in major halls including Carnegie Hall, Cooper Union, Symphony Space, Brooklyn Academy and St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City.

Mr. Doebler has received awards for research and teaching excellence from the University of Wisconsin and Ithaca College and has appeared throughout the eastern and midwestern United States as a clinician and guest conductor. As an editor of "no barline" Renaissance music, Mr. Doebler's editions are published by the Lorenz Company in the Roger Dean catalogue. In addition to his academic appointments, he currently serves as music director of the Cayuga Vocal Ensemble and has served as director of music at churches in Cleveland, St. Louis, Madison, and Ithaca.

Stephen M. Heyde is the Mary Franks Thompson Professor of Orchestral Studies and Conductor-in-Residence at Baylor University and the Conductor/Music Director of the Waco Symphony Orchestra. Mr. Heyde has conducted All State Orchestras and other festival orchestras in 28 states and continues to be in frequent demand in this capacity. In 2005, he will be conducting All State events in West Virginia and New York and has accepted invitations in Pennsylvania and Oregon for 2006.

Heyde has conducted ballet performances with the Indianapolis, Fort Worth, Tulsa, Austin, and Oakland companies, and a number of collegiate opera productions. He was selected as one of three clinicians for the *National Orchestral Symposium* sponsored by the University of Tennessee in 1986, made his European debut with the Krakow State Philharmonic in March 1998, and was invited to give conducting classes at Yale University and to conduct the Yale Symphony in November, 2002. A recipient of Outstanding Teacher Awards at West Virginia University and Baylor University, Mr. Heyde is a member of Pi Kappa Lambda, Mu Omicron and Texas Orchestra Directors Association, in addition to other professional associations. Mr. Heyde is President-Elect of the College Orchestra Directors Association.

As his capacity as Music Director/Conductor of the Waco Symphony Orchestra, Stephen Heyde has conducted many of the greatest artists living today, including Itzhak Perlman, Joshua Bell, André Watts, Pinchas Zuckerman, Aaron Rosand, Nadja Salerno-Sonnenberg, André-Michel Schub, Barry Tuckwell, Christopher Parkening, Ann Akiko Meyers, Jon Nakamatsu, Cecile Licad, Glenn Dicterow, Corey Cerovsik, Christian Lindberg, among many others and popular artists like Doc Severinsen, Henry Mancini, and Burt Bacharach, among others. This year's Waco Symphony season includes upcoming performances by Edgar Meyers and Barry Douglas, among others.

In October 2004, Stephen Heyde was invited to conduct the orchestra of the prestigious Liszt Academy in Budapest, Hungary. During his stay in Budapest, he was awarded the prestigious "Memorial Ring of the Liszt Ferenc Music Academy" and also accepted a position on the Curatorium (Board of Supervisors) for the Academy. While in Europe, Mr. Heyde also addressed the International Society for Music Education in Belgium and participated in a roundtable presentation of the International Kodaly Society.

Russel C. Mikkelson serves as Director of University Bands and Associate Professor of Conducting at the Ohio State University, where he conducts the Wind Symphony and Chamber Winds, guides the graduate wind conducting program, and oversees all aspects of the university's band program. Under his direction, the OSU Wind Symphony has performed at the 2001 and 2004 Ohio Music Educators Association Conventions and has recorded two CD's on the Mark Records label: *Jubilare!* and *Sounds, Shapes and Symbols*. A strong advocate for the creation of new works, Mikkelson serves on the Big Ten Band Directors Association Commissioning Panel, and has instituted a program of regular commissioning projects at OSU.

Dr. Mikkelson has received praise from composers Leslie Bassett, Krzysztof Penderecki, John Corigliano, Lukas Foss, Frank Ticheli, David Gillingham, and others, for his musical interpretation of their compositions. Mikkelson was a conducting fellow at the University of Wisconsin-Madison and holds the distinction of being that institution's first recipient of the DMA degree in instrumental conducting. Prior to his appointment at OSU, Professor Mikkelson was Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Music at the State University of New York-College at Fredonia, where he conducted the Wind Symphony, Concert Band, Orchestra, Opera, and Musical Theatre productions.

Dr. Mikkelson is Past President of the Big Ten Band Directors Association, a member of the College Band Directors National Association, MENC, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Phi Beta Mu, and was recently elected to membership in the American Bandmasters Association. He is active internationally as a guest conductor and clinician. Recent engagements include the High School All-State Bands of New York, Ohio, and Wisconsin, the West Virginia University Wind Symphony, the Suffolk County, Long Island, New York Honors Orchestra, and the Memorial University of Newfoundland in St. John's, Newfoundland, Canada.

Elizabeth B. Peterson is an Assistant Professor of Music Education and conductor of the All-Campus Band at Ithaca College in Ithaca, New York. Professor Peterson teaches undergraduate methods and conducting courses, and also supervises student teachers. She received a Doctorate in Musical Arts from Shenandoah Conservatory, her Master of Music degree from Northwestern University and Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Michigan. Before moving to Ithaca, Dr. Peterson was an arts administrator and Director of Bands at several public schools in Ohio and Illinois. Peterson played trumpet in the North Shore Community Band under the direction of John P. Paynter. Beth Peterson is active as a clinician and guest conductor. Currently,

Dr. Peterson is a co-conductor of the Ithaca Concert Band, Ithaca's adult community band.
